Changes to the Constitution:

The constitution is mainly based on the template provided by the Department of Fair Trading.

- Major changes to the Constitution include
 - The Committee can decide to not allow a specific member's application, no reason will be given.
 - Voting rights do not start until three months after officially becoming a member of the CCBC
 - Alternate members do not have the right to
 - Vote
 - Be a member of the Committee
 - Nominate a member of the Committee
 - Nominate a life member
 - Right of Appeal. Members may appeal decisions made by the committee but the rules have been changed as per the 2017 Constitution.
 - Decisions will be made by a simple majority of votes by members at Special General Meeting.
 - The Committee will have a minimum of 7 members and a maximum of 9 members.
 - There will be no limit on the term of office bearers on the Committee.
 - Service of Notice to members can be in writing via mail, email or personal
- The solicitor, Peter Owens, will review to new Constitution, which should take approximately one week.
